



Young Volunteer of the Year Nomination Guidelines

Celebration of Philanthropy 2018

Purpose: Award presented annually to a student, elementary school through college age with a proven record of volunteerism that, through their donations of time, talent, and financial resources, has played a key role in helping local nonprofit organizations provide services to the community.

The award is based on the individual's volunteer activities, originality and uniqueness of activities, impact of volunteer efforts, and success in leading/motivating other nonprofit volunteers in Anne Arundel County. To be eligible, all nominees must be under the age of 21 and live in Anne Arundel County.

Examples of relevant activities include tutoring, mentoring, designing social media tools for nonprofits, raising funds or goods (food, clothing, toys, etc.) for a homeless shelter, performing a public service to help build a playground, renovate housing, cleaning up a waterway, etc.

Nomination Form: Please complete the attached form. **IMPORTANT:** The form must be completely filled out in order for the nomination to be eligible. The nomination must be submitted by one or more nonprofits on behalf of the individual. *Nonprofits must gain the nominee's approval before submitting the nomination form.*

Nomination Process:

- ✦ All nominees will receive a recognition letter for being nominated from the Community Foundation of Anne Arundel County. The letter will include information on the nomination and selection process.
- ✦ At a meeting hosted by CFAAC, past recipients of the Celebration of Philanthropy Awards will review the nominations and select the 2018 recipients.
- ✦ Following the selection and prior to the public announcement, all nominees and the nonprofits who nominated them will receive a letter notifying them of the results.

Note: Recognition letters will be sent via certified mail. Public announcements will not be made until all nominees have received the certified letter.

Qualifications: Each nominee will be rated by the selection committee based upon the qualifications listed below. Please limit each response to 100 words or less and include no more than two supporting documents. Please note that the selection committee is made up of past recipients of the Celebration of Philanthropy Awards.

- ✦ Volunteer activities in Anne Arundel County (30 points)
- ✦ Originality and uniqueness of the approach used in a volunteer project or activity (20 points)
- ✦ Impact of volunteer efforts (20 points)
- ✦ Leadership and motivation of other nonprofit volunteers (30 points)
